<p>A nomination form provides a member the opportunity to nominate beneficiaries to receive death benefits in the event that the member's dies.</p> <p>A nomination form is valid only if it is in the possession of the Fund</p>	<p>The Trustees will apply the information provided in your nomination form to make fair benefit allocations of your death benefit.</p> <p>Failure to submit a valid nomination form may delay payment of benefits.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You are expected to complete and submit a nomination form when you join the Fund; and Your nomination form must be updated when there is a change in your living circumstances i.e., a change in marital status, birth of a child, or when you want to change your nominated beneficiaries. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete a hard copy (paper) nomination form and submit it to the Fund; Complete it electronically if you are registered for access to your own account on the fund's webportal. <p>The Nomination Form is available for download from the Fund's website or from one of the Client Service Centres</p>

WHO CAN BE NOMINATED TO RECEIVE MY DEATH BENEFITS?

DEPENDANTS	NOMINEES
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a person in respect of whom the member is legally liable for maintenance (spouse, children, legal & factual dependants); a person in respect of whom the member would have become legally liable for maintenance, had the member not died 	<p>Any non-dependent person may qualify as a nominee, provided that the deceased nominated him/her in a nomination form.</p> <p>The onus is placed on applicants to prove that they are eligible to receive a portion of the benefit.</p>
